

# Manly Cup 2024

Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2024

Manly Cup is back for its 20<sup>th</sup> year in 2024 and we are looking forward to another fantastic weekend of volleyball!

All team entries <u>must</u> be submitted via the Online Entry Form available online and all players must be registered members of NSW Volleyball or their Volleyball Australia-affiliated State Association.

A team will only be accepted into the Tournament upon submission of a completed Entry Form (including completed Team List) and receipt of Team Fees by MWVA. The nominated Team Representative will receive email notification upon successful entry into the competition.

MWVA will be capping divisions as required to ensure a fair and equitable competition for all competing teams. When a division is "full", teams will be invited to register on the waitlist for that division, and any waitlisted teams allocated to an expanded division will be allocated on a "first come, first served" basis where format restructuring allows.

#### Entries close at 5pm on Friday, April 12th , 2024.

Due to the unfortunate withdrawals of some teams at the last minute in recent years, please note that the following penalties will be enforced in the event of a team withdrawal:

- Withdrawal prior to 5pm on April 12<sup>th</sup> No penalty
- Withdrawal prior to 5pm on April 15<sup>th</sup> 50% Team Fee Penalty
- Withdrawal after 5pm on April 15<sup>th</sup> 100% Team Fee Penalty

As a reminder, if you are unwell, please do not attend this competition. This includes any cold or flu like symptoms e.g. cough, sore throat, runny nose or shortness of breath.

# Tournament Rules

## Tournament Rules

#### <u>Format:</u>

- **4** FIVB rules will apply except as amended;
- **4** The 12-sub rule will apply in all divisions (Numbered shirts are required for all divisions);
- **4** The "Libero Per Set" rule will apply in every set;
- 4 All Preliminary games will be best of 5 sets with a 60-minute time limit and 15-minute warm up prior to the start of play;
- A set will be deemed complete if one team has reached 13 points and has a 2-point lead, except in the 5<sup>th</sup> set which requires 8 points and a 2-point lead to be deemed complete;
- Where competition points are equal, pool positions will be determined by total sets for & against, then total points for & against. Where both of these are equal the winner of the match played between the two teams in question shall proceed as the higher-ranked team;
- Crossovers, Playoffs and Semi Finals will be best of 5 sets with a 60-minute time limit and 15-minute warm up, with the following rules for resolution at the end of

the playing time:

- If *completed* sets (i.e. to 25 pts) are unequal, then the team with the most sets wins regardless of the set in progress;
- Else if the last set can be deemed complete (i.e. reached 13 with a lead of 2) then the winner of the last set wins;
- Else if the *total* points are unequal then the team with the most *total* points wins, regardless of the margin;
- Else (sets & points are both equal) a "Golden Point" is played with a toss for serve / receive / end and the winner of the point wins.
- 🜲 Bronze Medal Matches will be best of three sets timed to 75 minutes (15-minute warm up, 60-minute game).
- 4 Grand Finals will be best of five sets with no time limit.

Competition Points:

- 4 Win 3 points
- 4 Draw 2 Points
- 4 Loss 1 point
- 4 Forfeit O points



### Tournament Rules

Game Interruptions:	No time outs or ordinary substitutions are permitted in the last 5 minutes of timed games. Duty teams should notify both captains when only 6 minutes of the game remains.	
<u>Duty Teams:</u>	All teams will be required to perform duty at designated times during the tournament and will be allocated as fairly as possible. Each Duty Team is required to provide:

	2 <sup>nd</sup> Referee; 斗	
	Scorer; and,	
	♣ 2 x Line Referees	
	Qualified referees will be appointed to 1 <sup>st</sup> Referee all Medal Matches where available.	
	Teams failing to fulfil their duty requirements will be penalised 4 competition points.	
<u>Player Transfers:</u>		
<ul> <li>A player may only play in one team per division;</li> <li>A player may only play for the team they register with, or a team in a higher division (ie players entered in Premier Divisions <u>will not</u> be</li> </ul>		

permitted to play in any Reserve Division or Division 1 team;
 No player may compete in any Crossovers, Playoffs, Semi Final or Medal Match of any division without having played in at least one preliminary round game for their team;

Female players may play in male divisions subject to approval of the Tournament Director: **4** Players wishing to play for both their Club / Association team, as well as a NSW State team,

may only do so after seeking approval from the Tournament Director.

<u>Protests:</u>	Protests will be dealt with by the Tournament Director in consultation with the Tournament Referee and their decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
